Se comprueba si hay pérdida de visión en un lado del campo visual, lo que puede indicar daño cortical o en vías visuales.

9. Extremidades

Se examinan la fuerza, coordinación y movimientos de brazos y piernas, incluyendo reflejos.

Cómo administrar la escala NIH Stroke Scale en español

- Evaluación global del déficit neurológico.
